Digital Simulation of Continuous Processes

A Symposium on Digital Simulation of Continuous Processes "DISCOP" will be held in Budapest Hungary, September 6 to 10, 1971 under the joint sponsorship of the IFAC Technical Committees on Theory and on Applications. The local organizers are the Hungarian Acedemy of Sciences, the Hungarian Chemical Society, the Scientific Society of Measurement and Automation and the Automation Research Institute of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences.

The aim of the Symposium is to summarize recent advances in the mathematical modelling of large continuous industrial systems for process control applications.

The basic topics for which offers of papers are solicited will be:

- General philosophy of modelling and simulation
- Steady state modelling and simulation methods
- Dynamic modelling and simulation methods
- Systems for modelling large industrial complexes
- Special simulation languages (steady state and dynamic)
- Process simulation for DDC and supervisory control
- Industrial applications.

General scope and special industry oriented papers will also be considered, excluding however methods for and applications in the metal and power industries.

Offers of papers with an abstract in English (20 - 30 lines) should reach the Organizing Committee by September 30, 1970 at the latest.

Information Processing in Measurement Systems

Sponsored by the Slovak Academy of Sciences the International Measurement Confederation - IMEKO - organized the first international Symposium on INFORMATION PROCESSING IN MEASUREMENT SYSTEMS from 7 - 9 October 1969, in Pezinok near Bratislava, CSSR.

25 papers dealt with the following topics:

- Information theory in modern measurement
- Optimization of measuring processes
- Theory of errors

- Modern methods of data reduction in measure-
- Novel measuring systems using such modern methods

The participants came to the conclusion that the subject of optimizing measuring processes both from the technical and the economic point of view would justify a special IMEKO seminar as considerable theoretical work is going on in this field. Such a seminar might also lead to a unification of terminology.
