Call for Papers

From February 21 to 25, 1977, an IFAC Symposium on AUTOMATIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION OF ELECTRIC POWER SYSTEMS, sponsored by the IFAC Technical Committee on Applications, will be held in Melbourne, Australia, with the participation of CIGRE. The Symposium is being organized by the College of Electrical Engineers of The Institution of Engineers, Australia, and Australian co-sponsors are the Institution of Radio and Electronics Engineers, Australia, and the Australian Computer Society, Inc. control centre hierarchies; centralised vs localised control; modern practice and equipment.
